I am writing in response to your e-mail of the 8th March 2024. Your request has been processed using the Trust's procedures for the disclosure of information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000).

Requested information:

We would very much appreciate your help with our national survey of Take-home Naloxone policy by answering these two questions.

- Does your organisation provide substance misuse services? Currently NSCHT
 provide substance misuse service in both inpatient and community. However,
 from 31/03/24 the Trust will be exiting the contract for community substance
 misuse service as Stoke Community Drug and Alcohol Service
- 2. Does your organisation have a policy on prescribing Take-home Naloxone for patients prescribed or taking opiates or opiate substitutes? Stoke Community Drug and Alcohol Service have a SOP for Naloxone however this has not been reviewed as we are exiting the current contract with local authority.
