The Trust have moved to a new data collection system form April 2024 which will accurately capture this for future service development.
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6.	The conversion rate of autism assessments to autism diagnoses through North Staffordshire Combined Healthcare NHS Trust for adults	Within the financial year of 2023/24, 70 Adult ASD diagnosis were given with a conversion rate of 73.6%.

7.	What support and further referral is routinely offered to children who receive an autism diagnosis through North Staffordshire Combined Healthcare NHS Trust.	All CYP and families are offered a post diagnostic support session to aid skills development following diagnosis. The Trust is currently expanding this offer to offer more psychoeducation sessions and life skills session on living well with an autism diagnosis
8.	What support and further referral is routinely offered to adults in who receive an autism diagnosis through North Staffordshire Combined Healthcare NHS Trust.	The Adult ASD Assessment service was a diagnostic only service with no post diagnosis support routinely offered. The Trust is currently expanding the post diagnostic support offer for our 18 – 25 aged service user group.
9.	What support and further referral is routinely offered to children who undergo an assessment for autism through North Staffordshire Combined Healthcare NHS Trust but do not receive a diagnosis.	Should a diagnosis not be reached following assessment with the CYP ASD service, CYPs and their families are signposted to the appropriate partner agencies who may be able to offer further support.
10.	What support and further referral is routinely offered to adults who undergo an assessment for autism through North Staffordshire Combined Healthcare NHS Trust but do not receive a diagnosis.	Should a diagnosis not be reached following assessment with the Adult ASD service, service users and their families are signposted to the appropriate partner agencies who may be able to offer further support.
11.	What standardised tools are currently used by North Staffordshire Combined Healthcare NHS Trust for the screening and/or triage of children who seek an autism assessment.	The CYP ASD service designed and implemented a range of screening and further information gathering tools to aid the review and triage of referrals received for an assessment of ASD.
12.	What standardised tools are currently used by North Staffordshire Combined Healthcare NHS Trust for the screening and/or triage of adults who seek an autism assessment	The Adult ASD service use the AAA screening tools.
