## Freedom of Information Act Request

I am writing in response to your e-mail of the 19<sup>th</sup> September 2024. Your request has been processed using the Trust's procedures for the disclosure of information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000).

## Requested information:

1. How many children (under18) have been referred to CYMPHS/ CAMHS in the last five years. (Between April 6 - April 5)? Can you provide the total number of children referred for each year; 2019/2020, 2020/21, 2021/22, 2022/23 and 2023/24.

Please note figures provided have been based on the number of children (under 18) that have been referred to either our Core CAMHS service or All Age Access service

2. For children referred this year alone (Between April 6 - April 5, 2023/24), how many received treatment? **1393** 

Please note that as a Trust we measure referral to treatment as referral to second contact. The figures above represent referral to second contact wait times.

- a. Between April 6 April 5, 2023/24, how many referrals to CAMHS were either deemed inappropriate or rejected? 467- This figure refer to inappropriate referrals
- b. Between April 6 April 5, 2023/24, what was the average and maximum waiting times for CAMHS treatments from referral to first appointment?

Average- 99.3

Maximum- 482

Please note that as a Trust we measure referral to treatment as referral to second contact. The figures above represent referral to second contact wait times.

Our ADHD pathway is currently integrated within our Core CAMHS services, in general patients within the ADHD pathway have extended waits compared to a patient accessing a Core CAMHS general pathway. We currently cannot disaggregate ADHD patients from our Core CAMHS patients.

c. Between April 6 - April 5, 2023/24, how many CAMHS patients were sectioned?

Please note that we have assumed that the above question is in relation to patients' section under the Mental health Act. This would infer to patient within our inpatient services and would not be relevant to our community CAMHS services.







3. As of September 2024, how many children and adolescents are on the waiting list for CAMHS? **124** 

Please note the above figure relates to patients waiting for referral to assessment (First contact) within a Core CAMHS service.
