I am writing in response to your e-mail of the 11th October 2024. Your request has been processed using the Trust's procedures for the disclosure of information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000).

Requested information:

- 1. Since the beginning of April 2024 how many nurses have left your Trust? **29 Headcount, 25.82 WTE**
- From the date of receipt of this request until March 31st, 2025, how many nurses are expected to leave your Trust? Based on the relevant turnover rate for the same period last year only - 49 Headcount, 43 WTE
- 3. What are your current total vacancies for nurses on the date of receiving this request? **101.26 WTE**
- 4. Does your Trusts have any plans to recruit internationally in the next financial year, April 2025 April 2026? **No**
