- 1. Does your Trust have any specific clinical care pathways, protocols, or service guidance specifically for the treatment or management of patients with:
 - Dissociative disorders (including DID, OSDD, DPDR etc..)? No
 - Complex post-traumatic presentations involving dissociation? No
- 2. If yes, please provide copies of any relevant documentation or pathway flowcharts. **N/A**
- 3. Which clinical teams or services (e.g. CMHTs, trauma services, personality disorder services, psychology/psychotherapy teams) typically provide care for patients with dissociative disorders and dissociative presentations? **N/A**
- 4. Does your Trust offer or commission any specialist assessment or treatment (e.g. SCID-D diagnostic assessment) specifically for dissociative disorders? **N/A**

The Trust is unable to provide a response to this question for the reasons below:

The Trusts Clinical Coding team records ICD-10 diagnosis codes following a patients stay within our inpatient services. This restricts our ability to provide ICD-10 codes for current inpatients as they will in majority have their ICD-10 diagnosis codes recorded post discharge from our inpatient services.

SNOMED diagnostic coding is not currently consistently being recorded within our community services. As a Trust we are working to fully embedded SNOMED diagnostic coding into our clinical system to enable us to respond to a request of this nature in the future.

If you are dissatisfied with the handling of your request, you have the right to ask for an internal review of the management of your request.
