## **Freedom of Information Act Request**

I am writing in response to your e-mail of the 6<sup>th</sup> September 2025. Your request has been processed using the Trust's procedures for the disclosure of information under the Freedom of Information Act (2000).

## Requested information:

I am writing under the Freedom of Information Act to request information regarding the use of simulation-based training within your Trust. Specifically, I would be grateful if you could provide the following details:

- Does the Trust currently use simulation to train any staff groups (e.g., consultants, resident doctors, nurses, allied health professionals, etc.)? Yes for physical health skills and dementia.
- If yes, what simulation methodologies are employed (e.g., role-play with actors, digital avatars, augmented reality, virtual reality, or other approaches)?
   We use mannequins, limbs with simulated veins and pulses, and mannequin body parts depending on teaching activity. We also access the local university medical and nursing simulation suite. We utilise virtual reality for Dementia Training.
- What were the initial setup costs for implementing simulation training?
   No cost for using university simulation suite. Set up costs for Virtual Reality training: £1500 headsets. Content developed in house cost neutral.
   Mannequins, limbs, etc: circa £10k
- 4. What are the ongoing annual costs, if any, associated with maintaining and delivering simulation training? **Trainer employment costs CIRCA £45K**
- 5. How many trainees did the Trust host in the last financial year (2024/2025) who were enrolled in training for a mental health–related profession? **837 total students** 
  - 803 Nursing students.
  - 34 AHP students.
